Forms of nomination for Parish/Town Council Elections may be obtained from Clerks to Parish/Town Councils (if they have requested them) or the Civic Offices, High Street, Epping, CM16 4BZ from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Civic Offices, High Street, Epping, CM16 4BZ from Monday 25 March until 4 pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 2 May 2019.
4. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Offices, High Street, Epping, CM16 4BZ by 5 pm on Monday 15 April 2019.
5. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Offices, High Street, Epping, CM16 4BZ by 5 pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019.
Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Offices, High Street, Epping, CM16 4BZ by 5 pm on Thursday 2 May 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019.
